## Introduction to Ultrasound

### Description

This 2-hour workshop introduces the attendee to two protocolized approaches using bedside ultrasound exam of the inferior vena cava and of the lung for assessment of hypotension and acute respiratory failure. The attendee will be introduced to basic machine functions that affect image quality, to transducer handling for image acquisition of the inferior vena cava and the lung, and to evidence-based interpretation of findings on the ultrasonographic exam, thus facilitating integration into diagnostic and therapeutic workflows for the critically ill.

### Learning Objectives

1. Ultrasound of lung for assessment of acute respiratory failure- technique and protocol-based evaluation
2. Ultrasound of inferior vena cava in assessment of shock -- technique and protocol-based approach
